The SDC advances the SLC's mission to provide opportunities for undergraduates to develop leadership and interpersonal skills, and to have practical experience and exposure within the earthquake engineering fields. Young Researchers Symposium

The Student Leadership Council (SLC) has organized a special session Tuesday afternoon, tailored specifically for the undergraduate students attending the Seismic Design Competition. This event will consist of presentations by undergraduate and graduate researchers, followed by a panel discussion in which practicing professionals, faculty members, and graduate students will share their experiences and answer questions about career options and life after graduation. Post-Earthquake Evaluation Workshop

The Student Leadership Council (SLC) has organized a post-earthquake evaluation workshop for students for Friday morning and afternoon. Additionally, students will have the opportunity to conduct field exercises to assess the damage to mocked-up buildings that have sustained earthquake damage.
